

Sunday's Guest

Paul Chitwood was elected president of the IMB in November 2018. He previously had served as executive director of the Kentucky Baptist Convention since 2011. For 18 years prior to that, Chitwood served as the pastor of local churches of varying sizes in Kentucky. During his pastorates, he served as chairman of the International Mission Board's trustees from 2008-10, part of his tenure as an IMB trustee from 2002-10. A native of Jellico, Tenn., Chitwood is a 1992 graduate of Cumberland College and earned the Master of Divinity and Ph.D. from The Southern Baptist Theological



Seminary and a master's degree in nonprofit administration from the Mendoza College of Business at the University of Notre Dame. He served as a faculty member of the seminary between 2002 and 2018. He and his wife, Michelle, have four children.





Send Relief: Morocco Earthquake



On Friday night, September 8, a powerful magnitude 6.8 earthquake struck Morocco's High Atlas Mountains. In an instant, buildings were destroyed and more than 2,900 lives were lost. More than 5,500 people have been injured. Most of the damage is in remote, mountainous villages that are hard to reach. The death toll is expected to rise as search and rescue efforts continue. Thanks to your generous giving, we were able to send funds to help with the Send Relief efforts in Morocco. Please pray for the people of Morocco as they process the physical and emotional devastation of the earthquake. Recovery will be a long-term process and Send Relief is committed to staying until the job is done.


