

Love Him through OBEDIENCE


WORK for Him

LIVING THE NEW LIFE

1. We're FREE

3. We're NOT Finished

- Salvation is a completed work
- Sanctification is an ongoing process (Philippians 1:6)



LESSON 3 BAPTISM



PHILIP AND THE ETHIOPIAN

ACTS 8:26-40

- 1. Philip listened and obeyed God's instruction, resulting in a divine appointment
- 2. Philip shared the good news about Jesus
- 3. The eunuch heard and believed
- 4. The eunuch desired to be baptized
- 5. Philip immediately baptized the eunuch
- 6. Baptism identifies us with the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus

Memory: "Peter replied, 'Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the Holy Spirit'." Acts 2:38

Extra Verses: Romans 6:1-4; Acts 16:30-33; Matthew 28:18-20



LESSON 4 PRAYER



SPEAKING TO GOD

MATTHEW 6:5-15

- 1. WHO? We are praying to our FATHER in Heaven
- **2. HOW?** We pray with FAITH, believing that He will answer: YES, NO, or WAIT. His WILL is always BEST!
- 3. WHERE? Pray in PRIVATE to be seen and heard by God
- 4. WHEN? We pray DAILY and depend on God's GRACE!
- 5. WHAT? PRAISE, PLANS, PROVISION, PARDON, and POWER



LISTENING TO GOD


MATTHEW 7:24-29

Memory: "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path." Psalm 119:105


Extra Verses: 2 Timothy 3:16-17; Hebrews 4:12; James 1:19-25

Memory: "...Believe on the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved" Acts 16:31


Extra Verses: Galatians 3:6-7; Romans 4:1-25; Colossians 3:1-17


PERSONAL TESTIMONY

THE GREAT COMMISSION


MATTHEW 28:18-20

- 1. JESUS unique BIRTH, LIFE, and DEATH
- 2. ALL AUTHORITY in heaven and earth belongs to Jesus!
- 3. GO to ALL NATIONS and MAKE DISCIPLES!
- 4. TEACH them to OBEY everything that JESUS commanded!
- 5. BAPTIZE them in the name of the FATHER, SON, and HOLY SPIRIT!
- 6. REMEMBER that Jesus will ALWAYS be WITH YOU!

Memory: "I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes." Romans 1:16

Extra Verses: John 3:16; 2 Corinthians 5:17-21

"But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: while we were still sinners, Christ died for us."


4. Romans 10:9-10

THE GREAT COMMANDMENT

LUKE 10:25-37

1. LOVE the Lord your God with all of your:

- **HEART** (passions, affections, purposes)
- **SOUL** (feelings, desires)
- STRENGTH (actions)
- MIND (thoughts)

2. LOVE your neighbor as yourself


Memory: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind; and love your neighbor as yourself." Luke 10:27

LESSON 11 GIVING



THE WIDOW'S OFFERING


MARK 12:41-44

- 1. The poor widow was faithful to GIVE
- 2. Her gift was an expression of her LOVE for God
- 3. Her gift was an expression of her FAITH in God
- 4. The value of our gift is determined by our sacrifice
- 5. What should we be giving towards?
 - The Great Commandment
 - The Great Commission

Memory: "And my God will meet all your needs according to His glorious riches in Christ Jesus." Philippians 4:19

Extra Verses: Matthew 6:1-4; Acts 4:32-37; 2 Corinthians 9:1-15





CELEBRATING THE LORD'S SUPPER

LUKE 22:7-20

- 1. The BREAD is symbolic of Christ's body, given for us!
- 2. The CUP is symbolic of Christ's blood that was shed for us, the blood of a New Covenant!
- 3. Eat and drink in remembrance of Jesus Christ
- 4. Four "looks" from 1 Corinthians 11:17-34

BACK: Remember Christ's death for our sin (v. 26a)

IN: Examine our hearts: confess and repent (v. 28)

AROUND: Consider other parts of body (v. 18-21)

AHEAD: Await His return and proclaim the Good News to others (v. 26b)

Memory: "For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes." 1 Corinthians 11:26

Extra Verses: Exodus 12; 1 Corinthians 11:17-30

Activity: Regularly remember Christ's sacrifice by observing the Lord's Supper!
