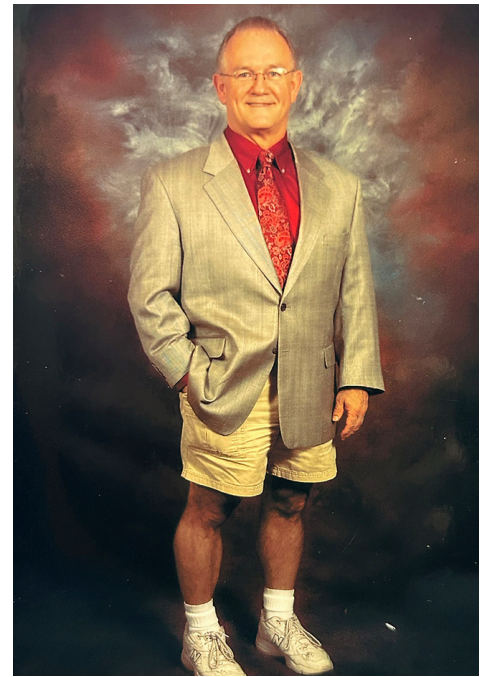

April Reach Trips

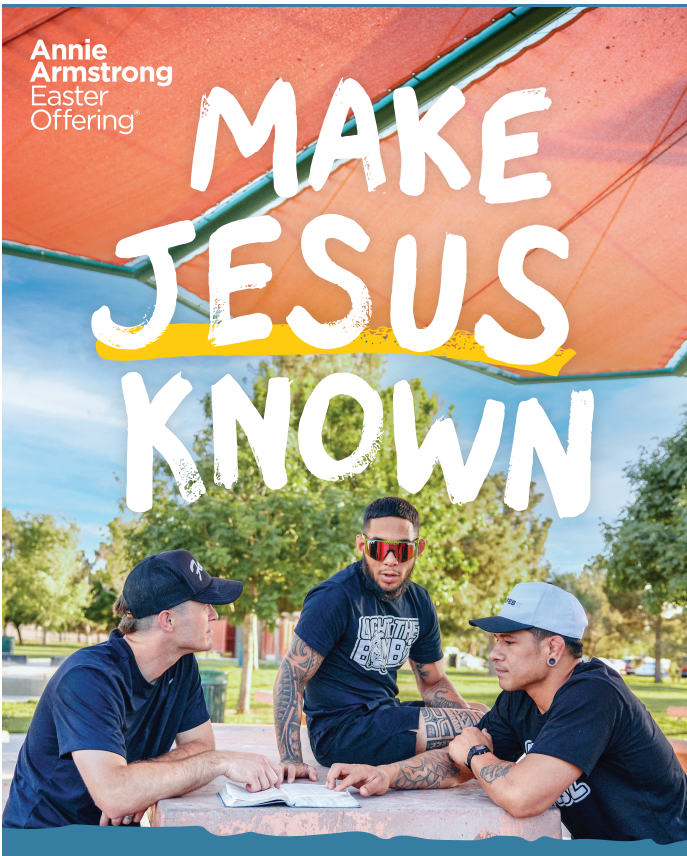
Join us as we pray for two Reach teams going out on international trips this coming April.

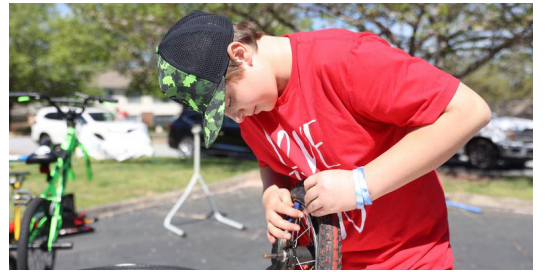
