



June 20 – 22: Myrtle Beach: News Travels Fast

Our team will be coming along side of Impact Church and their pastor, Wallace Evans. We will be having some directed community outreach events that are building on relationships created from the block party from the last Reach Team we sent in April.

- Pray for Impact Church's launch team. Ask that God would give them grace and steadfast confidence in Him as they approach the launch date of their church plant.

This summer, our team of 9 from Taylors will be working with Send Relief and Purpose LA, serving in various settings including rescue missions, local parks, and Skid Row. Our mission is to share the hope of the Gospel while meeting the physical needs of the people in LA.

- Pray for safe travel to and from the field, and for the protection of loved ones who remain at home.

June 22 – 29: New Hampshire: Kingdom Builders

- Pray for outreach events to lead to gospel proclamation and for lives to be impacted for the glory of God!

July 13 – 18: NC: Myanmar Manna Team

We will be partnering with Refuge Sports and Myanmar Life Church in Jamestown and Greensboro, North



Carolina. We will lead and assist with a Bible story and recreational camp for children in first through eighth grade from Burmese and Nepali refugee families.

- Please pray for our team's preparation of the material to teach the children. Also, the training of high school students from Life Myanmar Church the week before we arrive by Julie and Mike Lee.
- Pray for the children attending the camp, to come to know Jesus as their personal Lord and Savior, or, if they already know Him, to strengthen their relationship with Christ.
- Pray for the families of children who attend the camp and that we would have opportunities for gospel conversations, and also for the children as they share the Bible lessons at home.

Mission Trip Reports

Gavin Wenning, Ecuador

Hi, my name is Gavin Wenning and I had the privilege of going on my first mission trip to Ecuador. I have wanted to be a missionary since I was six years old. I traveled to Ecuador with my teen boys' group which I have been part of for several years. When we arrived in Ecuador we were hosted by missionaries, Steve and Carol Thompson, who have been doing the Lord's work in Ecuador for over 40 years. During



our stay at the missions camp we did some concrete work for a local church. Then we did a community outreach where we invited teens to come hear the word of God. During this special time with the local teens we played soccer and hosted a VBS. The teens that came to the VBS were so eager to hear God's word. I was able to share my own testimony that night with the teens.

Being in Ecuador and seeing how little material things they have but the joy of the Lord was always shining through their smiles was an encouragement to me. They seemed so happy. It really made me realize that things are not as important as having God in my life. That is the only thing that matters! I also learned so much from Steve Thompson, the missionary. He has really devoted his life to making relationships and guiding the Ecuador people in their walk with God. I am truly blessed to have been able to go on this trip. I want to thank Taylors First Baptist for praying for me and sponsoring a huge part of my trip. It was really life changing!


