Taylor's Nursery for babies, 9 weeks to 2-years-old

8:30 am, 9:40 am, and 11:00 am

Preschool Life Groups for Children age 3 through 5

8:30 am, 9:40 am, and 11:00 am

We use *Brite* curriculum for Preschool. During the 9:40 am hour, preschoolers visit the Sunshine Room for Preschool Praise where they sing, watch videos of the Bible story and memory verses and have prayer time.

Elementary Life Groups for Children 1st – 5th Grade

9:40 am

We use *The Biggest Story* curriculum for Elementary. Children will meet in their age graded classrooms before walking to the Kids Worship Room for prayer and our Bible story video. They will return to their classrooms to review the story and participate in a craft or activity.

Kids Worship for Children 1st – 3rd Grade

8:30 am and 11:00 am except for the first Sunday of each month

We use *New City Catechism* curriculum for Kids Worship. Children have their own worship experience through singing, looking up passages of scripture in the Bible, learning a new catechism question and answer, learning how to pray, and participating in games/activities.

Family First Sunday

On the first Sunday of each month, there is no Elementary programming during the 8:30 am and 11:00 am hours. Children should attend Worship with their families on these Sundays. Use this time to teach your elementary aged children how to worship corporately as the body of Christ.

Worshiper In Training

Children can be a worshiper in training with their parents on any given Sunday. If parents need tips or resources, please ask them to reach out to Lea Hardy, Minister of Children. We have bookmarks for children with tips as well as children's bulletins to utilize during the service.

Preschool Classes for Children age 3 through 5

Preschoolers will participate in scripture memory, recreation time on the playground or in the gym, and music in the Sunshine Room. They will be dropped off and picked up in their age specific classroom.

Konnect for Children 1st – 5th Grade

6:15 - 7:30 pm | Check-in Begins at 6:10 pm

Grades 1-5 will participate in game time, music, scripture memory and hearing from missionary speakers. They will be dropped off in the Rec Center and picked up in their age-graded classroom.

What To Expect

Taylor's Children at Taylor's FBC is a safe and loving environment where your child will receive excellent care. Each classroom is stocked with age-appropriate toys, furniture, and activities. Our volunteers come prepared to deliver engaging Bible lessons. Preschool uses Brite Curriculum and Elementary uses The Biggest Story. Your children will sing, play, and have hands-on activities that reinforce the lesson.

Our volunteers have been members at Taylor's FBC for at least six months, and have a cleared a background check. For the safety of the children, we only allow students and adults that have been through our volunteer training and background screenings to be present inside the classroom.

Check-in, Drop-off, and Pick-up

We ask that parents be present for check-in, drop-off, and pick-up of their children. Please do not allow children or siblings (unless they are 16 and older) to use the iPads or to pick-up children. Always remain on campus when your child is in our care, and be available should any emergency come up.

What To Bring

For infants/toddlers, please bring the following labeled items: a diaper bag with 2-3 diapers, pacifiers or other comfort items, change of clothes, and for infants, a bottle along with clear instructions on how to feed. Children can bring their Bible on Sunday mornings and Wednesday nights as well as a water bottle, if they'd like.

Snacks

On Sunday mornings during the 11:00 am hour, we serve Pepperidge Farms Goldfish Crackers with water for children age 2 through 5. Puffs are served in our crawler and 1 year old rooms.

Kids Worship at 11:00 am will receive fruit snacks, most Sundays. Please notify us if your child has any dietary restrictions/allergies.

Mothers Room

We offer a private nursing room near the preschool nursery hall on Sunday mornings and Wednesday evenings. We request that dads remain outside the room for the comfort of all mothers.

Potty Training

We understand that every child is different on their potty-training journey, and we certainly know that accidents happen. Let your child's teacher know when your child is potty training. If your child is in one of the preschool rooms and has an accident, we will notify you to have you assist the child in changing. Pack extra diapers and pull-ups along with a change of clothes and shoes.

Behavior/Discipline

We strive to create a safe and loving environment that will minimize behavior issues. If a child is struggling to respect others or their surroundings, we may notify the parent to help the child successfully rejoin the classroom environment. We expect all classroom teachers to demonstrate gentleness, forgiveness, and grace when administering any sort of intervention or redirection.

Your Child's Health

In order to provide the safest possible environment, we ask that you keep your child at home if they display any of the following signs of sickness within 24 hours.

- If child has a wet-sounding or dry cough, or sore throat
- If child has a fever 99.9 or above without medication (be fever free for 24 hours)
- If child has an upset stomach or vomiting
- If child has a rash
- If child has persistent runny nose with discharge
- If your child is lethargic
- If child has a contagious sickness

If a child in our care and begins to exhibit any of these symptoms, we will contact the parent to pick up the child. Toys that enter a child's mouth are placed in a bin to be sanitized according to DHEC regulations. Classroom tables, doorknobs, and floors are cleaned after services.

Safety Procedures and Evacuation

If there is an emergency and the children have to be evacuated, please do not go pick up your child. Our volunteers are trained with our procedures and will exit the building with all the children. You are able to pick up your children once you receive an all-clear. Depending on the situation, you will pick up your child outside or in their classroom.

Salvation and Baptism
