Taylors Women Care Ministry

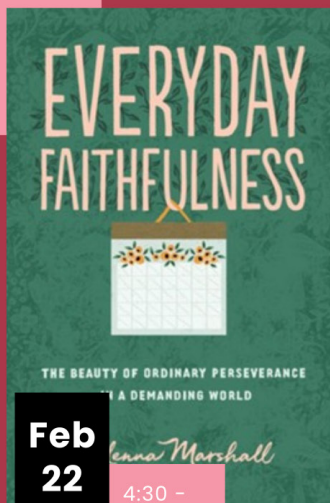

Our aim is to provide more opportunities throughout the year for women to connect over these topics and root themselves in the Word of God.

We have some regularly scheduled meetings already in place!

- Moms Mentoring Moms meets on Wednesday mornings — An opportunity for young moms to gain spiritual and emotional encouragement and social connections. 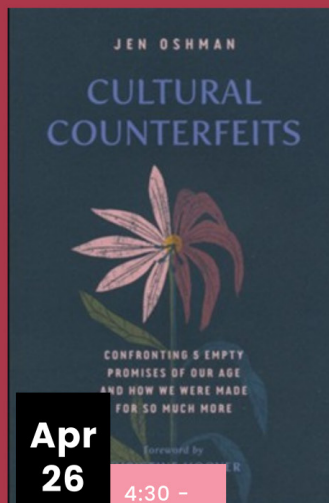

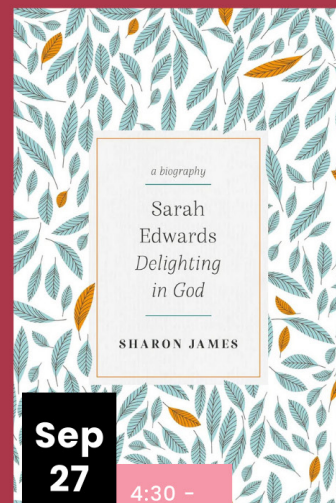

Taylors Seniors exists to create a spiritual environment founded and grounded in the authority of the Word of God through which Senior Adults experience salvation through Jesus Christ; having done so, they are then discipled to be disciple-makers.

Introducing XYZ+!

XYZ+ is a ministry initiative of Taylors First Baptist Church designed to serve and support adults age 55 and older. Built as a complement to the church's existing senior adult ministries, XYZ+ focuses on intentional discipleship, biblical encouragement, and meaningful connection during a season of life that brings both unique opportunities and challenges. Our first break out will be, "Caring for Aging Parents" beginning February 11. See the details below.

At the heart of XYZ+ is a commitment to pastoral care. The ministry offers structured breakout gatherings centered on biblical responses to some of life's most common and pressing issues — such as grief, aging, health concerns, caregiving, spiritual growth, and navigating life transitions. These breakouts provide a Christ-centered environment where participants can engage Scripture, share experiences, and receive encouragement rooted in God's Word.

XYZ+ is designed to foster community rather than isolation. Through thoughtful teaching, discussion, and prayer, participants are reminded that they are not walking through this stage of life alone. The goal is not only to inform, but to strengthen faith, deepen relationships, and equip senior adults to live faithfully and fruitfully for the glory of God.

It is important to note that XYZ+ is not taking the place of the current XYZ ministry. Instead, it exists alongside it, enhancing the overall senior adult ministry of Taylors First Baptist Church. XYZ+ provides an additional layer of focused care and discipleship, while honoring and preserving the ongoing fellowship, activities, and mission of XYZ.

Ultimately, XYZ+ reflects the church's desire to love, serve, and shepherd senior adults well — helping them apply biblical truth to everyday life.
