We are passionate about using sports and fitness to create environments that build community with the purpose of sharing the Good News. We seek to engage those around us by providing spaces where people can practice and play sports on our campus. We value helping those who call this their home gym to be good stewards of their bodies, so they can remain active where they live, work, and play.



FITNESS is an environment we are thankful to provide, allowing people to care for their bodies well. We desire for believers to be active in the places where they live, work, and play. Taking care of our bodies is one way we can glorify God. Our hope is that the healthier and more active we are, the more opportunities we will have for Gospel conversations. We offer a variety of fitness classes that create community through encouragement and shared prayer requests. Our weight room is rarely overcrowded, and the walking track provides a great alternative when it's too hot or cold outside. The basketball courts offer multiple options, but you will most often find a strong community playing pickleball in the mornings and some afternoons, along with basketball throughout the day.

SPORTS provide a space where we can build meaningful connections with families at Taylors FBC and in the surrounding community. We recognize that each sport has the potential to reach different families, which is why we offer options such as basketball, baseball, and soccer. During this past season, we connected with over 300 families who chose us as their sports home. Our coaches love Jesus and have weekly opportunities during practices and games to connect with both parents and kids.






PARTNERSHIPS are important to us, and we strive to be intentional in the relationships we build with schools and organizations that use our facilities. We are grateful for the generosity of Taylors FBC and the vision that made this facility possible. This year, we partnered with seven different schools across the Upstate for practices, clinics, and games. We also maintain ongoing partnerships with organizations like Hoops University and Weight Watchers, which provide valuable training and support for our community.

Outreach opportunities at Taylors Rec happen daily. Outside of basketball season, we welcome an average of 200 people through our doors each day—and that number triples during the season. We are also celebrating three years of our basketball outreach ministry, which has seen over 500 individuals come through to play and hear the Gospel. It is our desire not only to serve those on our campus but also to take what we do into nearby neighborhoods and schools, reaching more people with the message of Jesus. The consistency and support of our members also allow us to financially contribute to the outreach efforts of our church as a whole.










tsm Encounter Weekend






Arabic Church Plant

Taylor's First Baptist Church is joyfully serving as the host church for an Arabic church plant, celebrating the opportunity to open its doors to a new congregation reaching Arabic-speaking individuals and families. This partnership reflects a shared commitment to the Great Commission and a desire to see the nations worship Christ—right here in the Greenville area.

As a church ministering primarily in Arabic, this congregation provides a welcoming spiritual home for Arab-speaking believers and seekers alike. It serves individuals from a variety of backgrounds—including Muslim and Orthodox traditions—who are exploring Christianity or seeking fellowship in a culturally familiar environment.

At the heart of this ministry is a commitment to making the Christian faith accessible and understandable. By teaching the Bible in Arabic, the church helps individuals engage with Scripture in their heart language, allowing for deeper understanding and personal connection.

The church's mission is lived out in several key ways:


- Biblical teaching in Arabic, equipping individuals to understand and grow in their faith.
- Cultural bridge-building, creating a welcoming space that honors diverse backgrounds while easing the transition into a new faith community.
- Community outreach, fostering meaningful relationships through shared meals, social gatherings, and service opportunities.
- Evangelism and discipleship, inviting people to explore the teachings of Jesus Christ in a supportive, respectful, and accessible setting.


For many Arabic speakers—especially those from Muslim or Orthodox backgrounds—this church becomes a place of discovery and belonging. Here, individuals can explore core Christian beliefs in a non-judgmental environment, ask honest questions about faith and salvation in a language they understand, and build friendships with others who are familiar with both Western and Middle Eastern cultures.

The mission of the Arabic Baptist Church in the Greenville area is clear: to bring the message of Jesus Christ to every tongue and nation. Through Arabic-language worship, intentional evangelism, and authentic community connection, the church seeks to create a space where faith can be explored sincerely and where lives can be transformed by the love of God.

Whether welcoming someone with questions about Jesus or walking alongside those seeking a new spiritual community, this ministry is marked by compassion, clarity, and cultural awareness.

This vision is carried out through daily devotions, weekly worship services, and monthly home gatherings—spaces where all God-seekers are invited to come, experience familiar language and music, share in meaningful fellowship, enjoy traditional foods, and hear the hope of the Gospel.





Monthly Prayer for Unengaged Unreached People Groups

A UUPG is a distinct cultural or language group with no known active church-planting strategy or missionary presence, and less than 2% evangelical population. The IMB (International Mission Board) estimates there are over 3,000 such groups, comprising about 290 million people who lack access to the Gospel.

For the month of April, we ask that you pray over the Jethi people group of India.

The Jethi are an unengaged, unreached people group located predominately in Andhra Pradesh with smaller numbers in Karnataka and Tamil Nadu. There are about 26,500 of them and they speak Telugu. They were traditionally wrestlers and gymnasts and the women of the community are known as bone doctors who set broken bones and cure knee and neck pain.

Pray that these people, whose name some believe comes from the word jayest which means 'one desirous of victory,' would desire for death to be swallowed in victory through Jesus Christ as it says in 1 Corinthians 15:54-57, "Death has been swallowed up in victory. Where, O Death, is your victory? Where, O Death, is your sting?" The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ."

In the coming days, from Resurrection Sunday to Pentecost Sunday, we will focus more on gospel sharing, discipleship, and church planting.

Plan to gather in the Fellowship Hall for prayer and breakfast at 8:00 am before we head out to our assigned projects. Families are encouraged to participate together!




