We encourage women to read their Bible daily, pray, and fellowship with believers. We highlight one of these each year and stir each other to make these daily "habits".



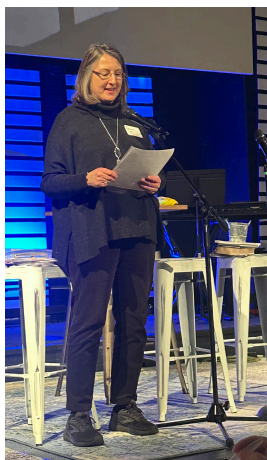
### Events

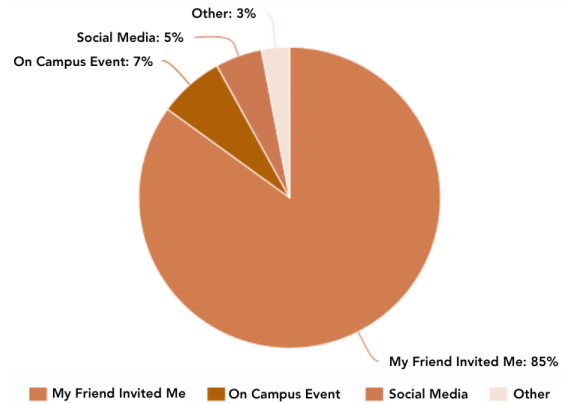

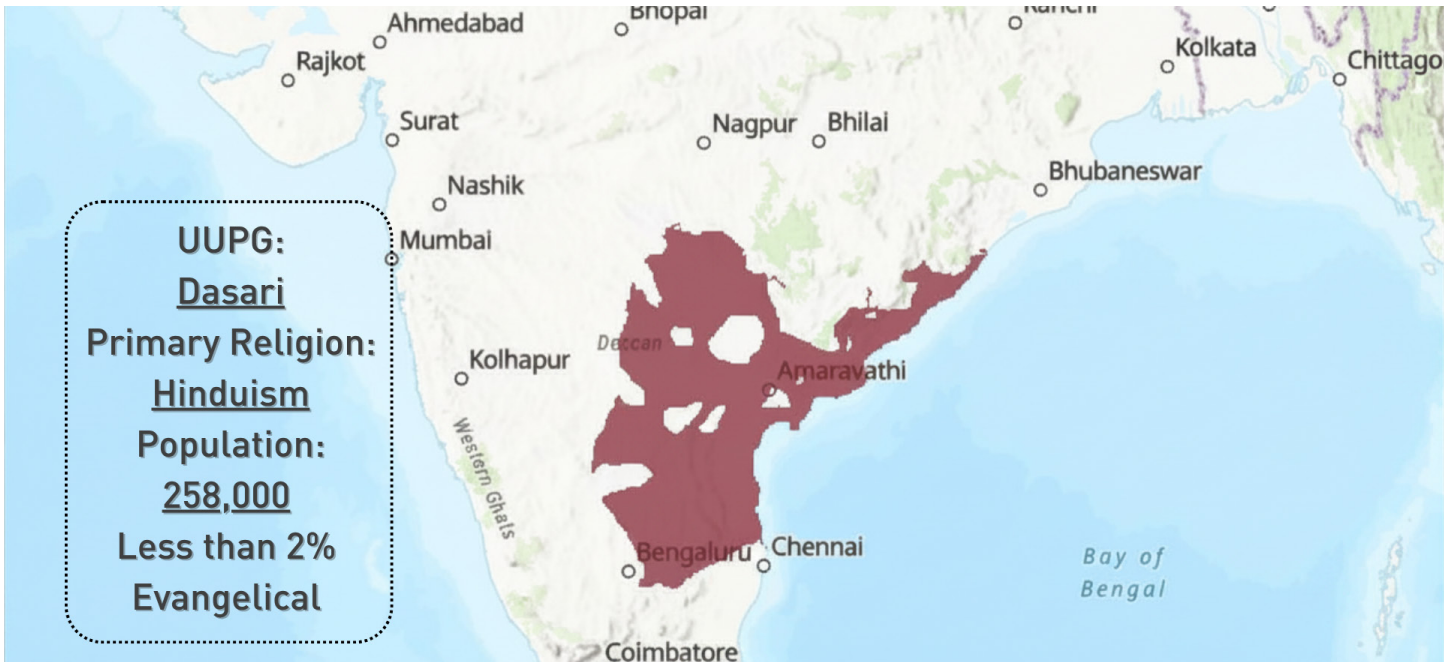

## Monthly Prayer for Unengaged Unreached People Groups

A UUPG is a distinct cultural or language group with no known active church-planting strategy or missionary presence, and less than 2% evangelical population. The IMB (International Mission Board) estimates there are over 3,000 such groups, comprising about 290 million people who lack access to the gospel.

### For the month of May we ask that you pray over the Dasari people group of India.

The Dasari are a Hindu, unengaged, unreached people group numbering about 258,000 who live throughout Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Karnataka, and Tamil Nadu. They hold a wide array of jobs but many of them are centered around begging. They can be identified by the things they carry: a conch shell, a metal gong, a long iron lamp post, a copper vessel, and a small metal image of Hanumantha, the monkey god. They have a strong history of oral traditions which focuses on preserving their Hindu culture and these stories have been incorporated into the street plays they often perform.

- Please pray that the Dasari, whose name literally means 'servant of god,' would one day consider themselves servants of the Most High God, the Only God.
- Pray that someone would share Jesus Christ with them and that the Spirit would convict them of the truth of Christ.
- Pray that as they come to faith they would resist the persecution that will come and stand strong for the Lord, enduring through all hardships.
- Pray that 2 Corinthians 6:4 would be their heart's cry: "Rather, as servants of God we commend ourselves in every way: in great endurance; in troubles, hardships, and distresses."

## Mission Partner Update

Ellie Bohler- IMB, Germany | Black Forest Academy

### Story

As a guidance counselor at Black Forest Academy, I help students make plans for what comes after high school. Last year, I worked with a challenging student, Daniel,\* who avoided conversations about the future and skipped every one of our scheduled meetings. He graduated, and I assumed that was the end of our relationship. However several months ago, I received an email from Daniel, asking for help with applying to college, and sharing more about his situation with me. Daniel's family are Christians from a Central Asian nation, and his parents serve as workers\* in a nearby country. Daniel was worried he wouldn't be able to attend college, due to political instability in the region and his family's limited finances. We had never had spiritual conversations while he was a student, but his anxiety over the future opened the door for me to tell him I was praying for him, and share that God has a plan for his life. I was able to connect him with a Christian college that has a heart for the harvest, and they accepted Daniel and provided enough scholarship to meet his financial need. Last week I received another email from Daniel, telling me how excited he is, and asking for prayer that his visa will come through.

In the process of helping Daniel, I have been reminded that even when we think that a chapter is finished or that the window of opportunity has closed, our times are in God's hand. I continue to pray for Daniel - that he sees how God has provided for him in this next step, and that he will know that it is the Lord who gives us a hope and a future.

### Challenge

Something I have been struggling with lately is honoring God in decisions to work or rest. When I get home from work, it's hard to talk myself into wanting to spend more time with students. I find myself not wanting to say yes to commitments in the evening, but then struggle with feeling selfish with my time and not venturing outside of my comfort zone to see what God will do.

### Prayer Requests

1. Pray for God to grow the faith of my high school girl's small group, and that the one who does not yet know Him would realize her need for salvation.
2. Pray that our school will have wisdom in navigating difficult situations with families, and that even in the midst of having hard conversations that we would encourage them.
3. As I prepare to teach for the first time next year, pray that I will honor God through my teaching, and that He will provide opportunities to minister to my student's souls as well as their minds.

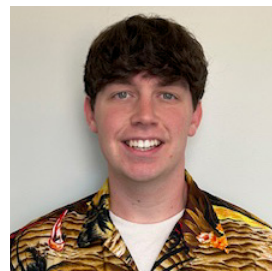
